Instructions

- 1. A pot is placed somewhere on the floor in the play area and a treat is placed under the pot.
- 2. A child is blindfolded and must crawl around the floor, tapping with the wooden spoon or stick until they find the pot. If the child is having trouble locating the pot hints may be given to help them by saying 'hot' or 'cold' to indicate if they are close (hot) or further away (cold) from the pot.
- 3. When the pot is found the blindfold is removed and the treat is collected. It is then the next child's turn.





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
